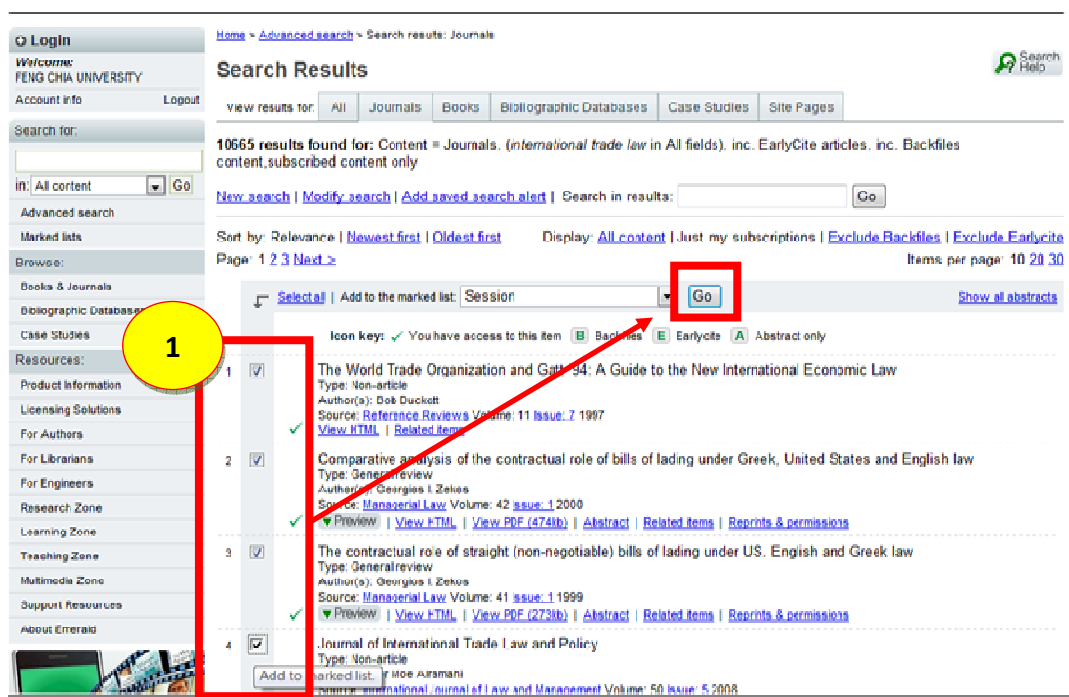
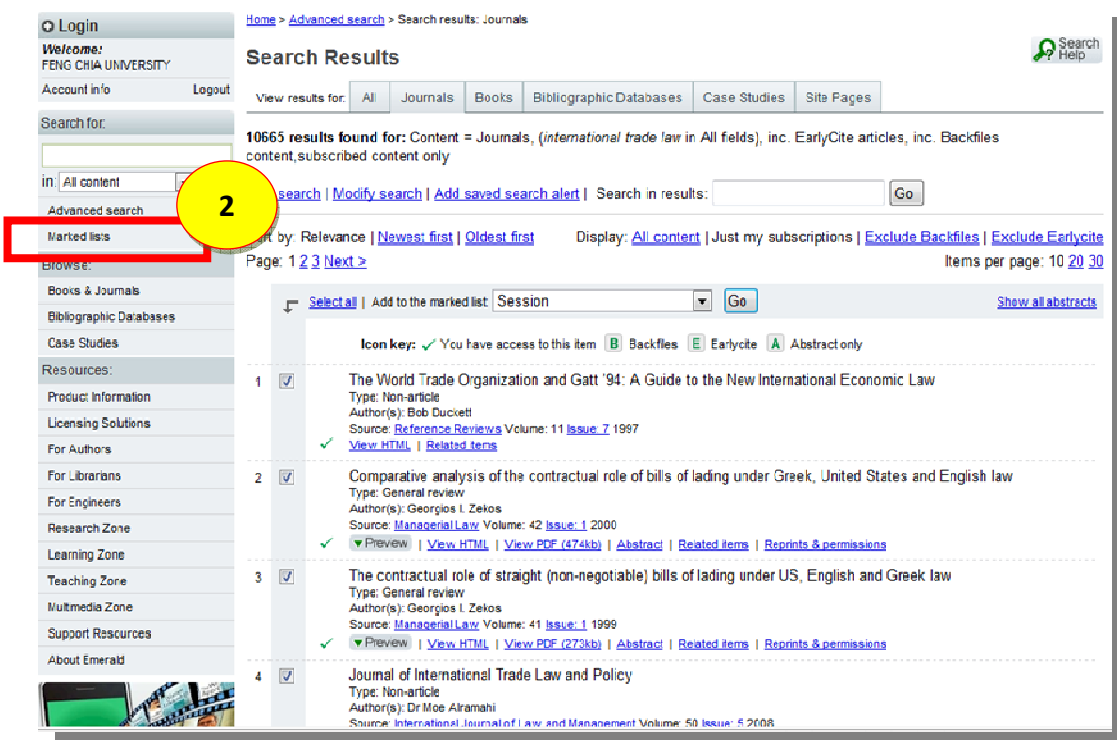


Step1. 在書目列表，勾選欲匯至 EndNote 的書目資料後，按 Add to the marked list **Go**。


